Matthew 7:15-23

“Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. ¹⁶ You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? ¹⁷ So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. ¹⁸ A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. ¹⁹ Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰ Thus you will recognize them by their fruits. ²¹ "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. ²² On that day many will say to me, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?' ²³ And then will I declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.'”

I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole counsel of God. ²⁸ Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood. ²⁹ I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; ³⁰ and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them. ³¹ Therefore be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish every one with tears. ³² And now I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. ³³ I coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. ³⁴ You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my necessities and to those who were with me. ³⁵ In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, 'It is more blessed to

give than to receive." 36 And when he had said these things, he knelt down and prayed with them all. 37 And there was much weeping on the part of all; they embraced Paul and kissed him, 38 being sorrowful most of all because of the word he had spoken, that they would not see his face again. And they accompanied him to the ship.

Jeremiah 23:19-29

Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you. They make you worthless; They speak a vision of their own heart, Not from the mouth of the LORD. 17 They continually say to those who despise Me, 'The LORD has said, "You shall have peace"; And to everyone who walks

according to the dictates of his own heart, they say, 'No evil shall come upon you.'" ¹⁸ For who has stood in the counsel of the LORD, And has perceived and heard His word? Who has marked His word and heard it? ¹⁹ Behold, a whirlwind of the LORD has gone forth in fury-- A violent whirlwind! It will fall violently on the head of the wicked. ²⁰ The anger of the LORD will not turn back Until He has executed and performed the thoughts of His heart. In the latter days you will understand it perfectly. ²¹ "I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran. I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied. ²² But if they had stood in My counsel, And had caused My people to hear My words, Then they would have turned them from their evil way And from the evil of their doings. ²³ "Am I a God near at hand," says the LORD, "And not a God afar off? ²⁴ Can anyone hide himself in secret places, So I shall not see him?" says the LORD; "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" says the LORD. ²⁵ "I have heard what the prophets have said who prophesy lies in My name, saying, 'I have dreamed, I have dreamed!' ²⁶ "How long will *this* be in the heart of the prophets who prophesy lies? Indeed *they are* prophets of the deceit of their own heart, ²⁷ "who try to make My people forget My name by their dreams which everyone tells his neighbor, as their fathers forgot My name for Baal. ²⁸ "The prophet who has a dream, let him tell a dream; And he who has My word, let him speak My word faithfully. What *is* the chaff to the wheat?" says the LORD. ²⁹ "Is not My word like a fire?" says the LORD, "And like a hammer *that* breaks the rock in pieces?



Communion Today is for Members Only Please



1 Corinthians 2:10-11 (EHV) – *“But God revealed it to us through his Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God. Indeed, who among men knows a man’s thoughts except the man’s spirit within him? So also, no one else knows God’s thoughts except God’s Spirit.”*

Tim “The Toolman” Taylor (from the sitcom Home Improvement, 1991-1999) said, “Real Men don’t need instructions.” As a red-blooded American man I agree with that sentiment, even if I have to go back to Menards at least 4 times to complete a project. We may not need instructions, but we do occasionally need some direction. The Holy Spirit gives us that direction in the above verses.

The verse before our text tell us that no mind can conceive what God has prepared for those who love Him—this God reveals to through His Spirit (in His Word). I love the logical progression in these verses. I love the fact that God doesn’t leave us to guess, He gives us direction. God doesn’t tell us to ask a wise man. He doesn’t tell us we need “more power” like ‘The Toolman’ would say. He would have us sit still and listen to Him. He doesn’t ask us to understand everything. He asks us to take Him at His Word.

So even as you can’t know what I’m thinking—unless I tell you—so, we can’t know what God is thinking and planning unless He tells us. Where we don’t know everything (even though we may think so), the Spirit of God does know everything, especially the thoughts and plans of God. There is no one better equipped to tell us than the Spirit of God.

The Spirit of God reveals to us (in the Bible, God’s Word) what God has prepared for those who love Him. He tells us that He solved the problem of sin by making His Son accountable for sin. He suffered and died to free us from the demands and condemnation of the righteous Law of God. He has prepared a place for us apart from sin, death and sorrow.

Best of all, He tells us how to get there. Jesus is the Way. I may not know very much, but I do know that Jesus loves me.

Daily Bible Readings for Home Devotions

July 22nd – 27th, '24

"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."

-Psalm 119:105

Mon Mark 8:34-38 Jesus calls to both crowd and disciples. To follow Him is to walk not the way of comfort but of the cross (instrument of death). To avoid the way of the cross is to lose the life that He came to give us.

Tues Acts 16:12-15 Luke has joined Paul's group of missionaries and tells how the Lord called to Lydia by the riverbank and opened her heart to receive the Gospel. Both she and her household are baptized, and she wants to serve the cause.

Wed Exodus 3:1-14 The Lord calls to Moses from a burning bush which is not consumed. It is the right time to answer His people's cries for help. They will be saved from Egypt through Moses, but it will be the great "I Am" who will save them.

Thurs Isaiah 54:7-8 A picture worth repeating: The Lord calls to His people like a bridegroom speaking to His wayward and restored bride. In everlasting mercy He will have compassion on them. He is their Redeemer, the Lord.

Fri Isaiah 54:9-10 God calls to His people as He spoke to Noah after the flood. His mercy is everlasting, and even if there is no mountain to set one's foot upon, yet His mercy will not be removed, His covenant of peace will remain.

Sat Isaiah 54:11-13 The Lord calls to His people as to a ruined city. Even the lowliest parts of your buildings will sparkle with sapphires and rubies. Even your boundaries will shine with precious gems. All your children will be taught by the Lord.
